American Rescue Plan funds are available through the National Endowment for the Arts

Deadline: August 12

American Rescue Plan funds are available through the National Endowment for the Arts for organizations that can demonstrate a three-year history of arts programming. Significant funding is available: \$50,000, \$100,000 and \$150,000 awards that **DO NOT REQUIRE A MATCH!** The deadline to apply is August 12. No prior experience with grant writing is required.

The NEA is particularly interested in:

- Organizations that serve populations whose opportunities to experience the arts are limited by ethnicity, economics, geography, or disability;
- Organizations with small and medium-sized budgets and from rural to urban parts of the country; and
- Organizations that are applying to the Arts Endowment for the first time

Even if you are receiving ARP funds through the Nebraska Arts Council, you are still eligible to apply directly to the NEA.

Individual Artist Fellowship for Visual Artists

Submission Deadline: November 15

The 2022 Individual Artists Fellowship (IAF) program recognizes originating Visual Artists in Nebraska. Applicants are competitively adjudicated by a professional panel according to the merit of their work and recognizes exemplary work by Nebraska artists and provides support for presentations, training, research, and/or creation of new art for one year through monetary stipends of \$1,000 - \$5,000.
