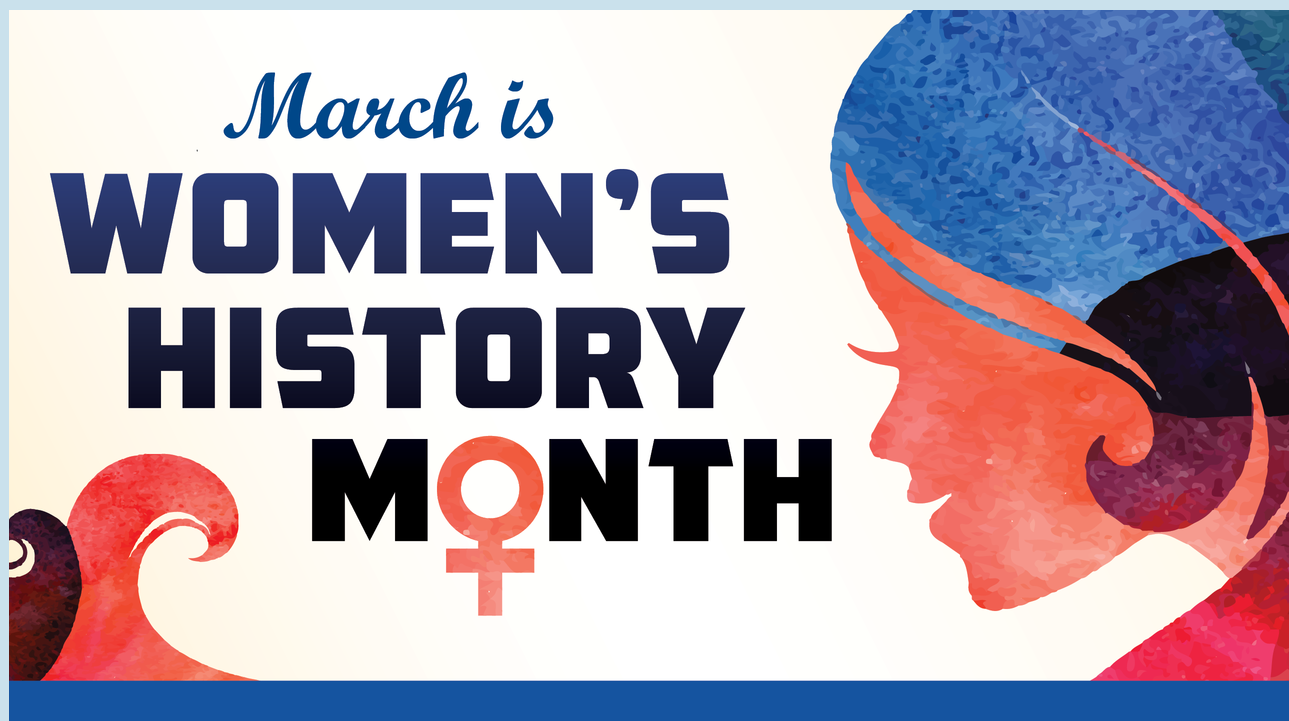

Associate of Science (AS) degree in Game and Interactive Media Art Design, Production Management. The degree path will provide instruction for creating digital art assets for games and interactive media arts (virtual/augmented/mixed realities, virtual filmmaking, projection mapping, and related interactive media events) using industry-standard software, game engines, and Artificial Intelligence. The program is constructed to provide an emphasis on designing and creating digital art assets for production and managing these projects using an iterative process and the associated budgeting, scheduling, and program management pipelines.
