# **Colombian Journeys**

- **New entry fee for Canadian travelers.** As of November 14th, the Colombian government has reintroduced a fee for Canadian travellers entering the country. The payment of COP \$253,000 or its equivalent in Canadian dollars (around 86 CAD), will be for the control and verification procedure in the system. Once the passengers arrive in national territory, they will be able to make the payment by dataphone at the immigration control post. *Exceptions apply for minors under 14 years of age and whose destination of entry and stay in Colombia is the Archipelago of San Andres, Providencia and Santa Catalina*.
- Best Tourism Villages 2023. The World Tourism Organization (WTO) in its 29th General Assembly named the best tourism villages of 2023. Among the 260 applicants only 54 villages were selected, of which 2 are Colombian: Zapatoca in Santander and Filandia in Quindío. This recognition highlights the efforts of these rural towns and their commitment for preserving community-based values, innovation, and sustainable development. In addition, the small town of Iza in Boyacá was selected to participate in the Best Tourism Village Upgrade Programme in order to be part of the 2024 winners list.
- Cartagena, best cultural city. In the TravelBook Awards 2023, Cartagena was chosen as the "Best Cultural City" in the world, recognizing its extensive cultural

heritage, welcoming atmosphere, and human warmth of the local community. In this city with colorful streets, flower decorated balconies and colonial buildings of more than 500 years old, travelers can visit the **Old Historic Center**, its **magnificent palaces**, the **Aduana plaza**, the **Gold Museum**, the **Naval Museum**, the **Museum of Modern Art**, among other things. The city has a great cultural richness that makes it stand out as one of the most impressive cultural destinations in South America.

• One of the coolest neighborhoods in the world is in Medellin. Each year, TimeOut Travel magazine gathers the opinions of more than 12,000 readers about the neighborhoods that attract the most tourists and local visitors. This year, the Laureles neighborhood in Medellín was chosen as the coolest in the world, known for its entertainment offer with a variety of restaurants and bars, being the home of the Atanasio Girardot Stadium and being surrounded by relaxing areas including parks, tree-lined streets, yoga studios and cafeterias.
