Permission to Post is a practice for young people and their families to use when posting and sharing personal information, location, pictures and videos of yourself and others online, allowing for better, more thoughtful decision making.

What are some reasons why we should get Permission to Post personal information, location, pictures and videos before posting online?

- We don't want to freely share our personal information like our age/birthdate, name, location, school, banking info, address etc without making sure our Askable Adult has approved it. This is a strategy to support our safety and privacy.
- We don't want to share pictures and/or videos of ourselves and others unless they have agreed to it or a parent has approved it.
- We want to feel good about what we share online of ourselves and others.
- We want to be a good, respectful friend and member of our family.
- We don't want to sneak pictures and videos of people who may not know they are being recorded.
- There may be religious or personal reasons why someone doesn't want their picture shared online.
- Adults should be as conscious and considerate when posting about their children online. Permission to Post is a strategy adults and children can practice.
- We want to be good digital citizens smart, safe and savvy.
