prospect that our university is not living up to our high ideals, especially when it comes to protecting our students when they need us most.



Recent media reports alleging that we have mishandled reports of sexual assault and violence are a stark reminder that the gains we have made in our reporting, investigating, and processing of Title IX claims in recent years are not enough. One victim of sexual assault on our campus is one too many, and the same holds true for anyone whose report is not properly handled. We must do better going forward - and we will.

As always, our actions will speak louder than our words. We've commissioned Husch Blackwell to conduct an independent, comprehensive review of our Title IX policies and procedures. We chose this firm for its expertise in higher education law as well as its objectivity — we don't have any ongoing business relationship with Husch Blackwell at any of our LSU campuses, health sciences centers, or foundations. Their investigation is already underway and it should wrap up in February, with a public report issued at that time. We will deal swiftly and appropriately if the findings show indifference or mishandling of cases on the part of anyone at LSU. In the meantime, we will continue to investigate every report of violence or sexual abuse, and we will hold those responsible accountable.

Executive Vice President & Provost Stacy Haynie and I are meeting with LSU's student leaders to hear more about their experiences and perspectives, and we are seeking input from faculty and staff on their ideas about improving our processes. We are also consulting with the Baton Rouge Sexual Trauma Awareness and Response (STAR) Center as we work to do better in the future. I have issued a memo to all university leaders to reinforce the obligation all LSU employees have to report knowledge of a sexual or domestic assault to the Title IX Office (with extremely limited exceptions for those in designated, confidential roles). We will further address the topic at our Faculty & Staff Forum on Dec. 2, and mandatory campus-wide Title IX training is required of all employees by Dec. 31.

We will admit those instances in which we have not lived up to our high ideals and hold ourselves accountable. Perfection may not be attainable, but in pursuing it we will become a safer, more informed, and more compassionate community. Together, as a community, we can make the necessary changes to protect our LSU family by addressing the underlying causes of sexual and domestic violence and changing that culture for good.
