Born of Fire & Clay: Pueblo Pottery Workshop, May 2023

Maxine, Dominique, and Mia Toya (Pueblo of Jemez) spent a week working with Thayer Zaeder's ceramics classes this spring. With clay and temper from New Mexico, students created their own figurines and vessels using traditional decorative techniques of painting and polishing. The workshop culminated in a tradition Jemez firing. Dominique Toya, her mom Maxine, and sister Mia have distinctive pottery styles, ranging from Dominique's swirled vessels, to Maxine's owls and town crier figurines, and Mia's lidded vessels. Pictured here is Mia Toya working with a PA student on creating a butterfly lid for their clay vessel.


