EURē**CA**

Present your research **by poster** at the largest undergraduate research event on campus for the opportunity to win cash prizes. Submit your abstract by March 11 here.

Undergraduate Research Symposium

For **oral presentations**, present at the 10th Annual Undergraduate Research Symposium put on by the Undergraduate Research Student Association (URSA). Submit your abstract by March 8 <u>here</u>.

3 Minutes to Win It Research Challenge

For a more creative route, submit a 2-3 minute **original video** showcasing your research (and yourself!) for a chance to win an iPad or cash. Submit by March 5 <u>here</u>.

The Undergraduate Awards

Submit a research **paper or project** that you did for a class (graded A- or above) for a chance to win an international award and a trip to Dublin, Ireland to attend the Global Summit. Submit anytime between now and June 11 <u>here</u>.
