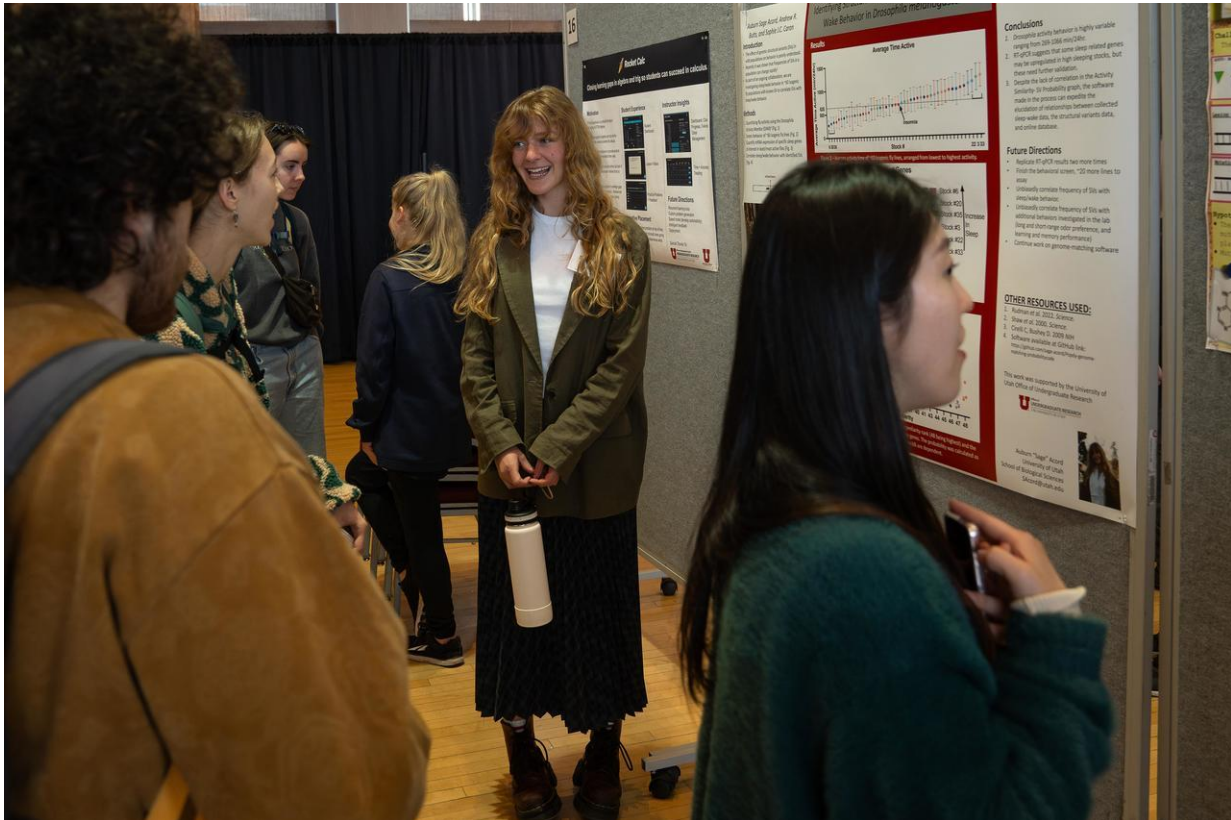


March 2025

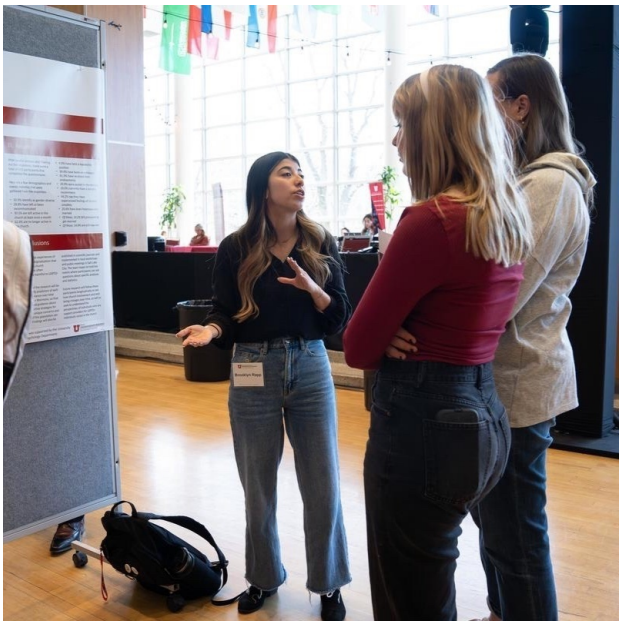
