

Summer Research Internships

Funding is available for internships to promote research and creative activity among undergraduate students. All current full-time undergraduate students enrolled at the Knoxville campus are eligible to apply. Students graduating in May or August 2019 are not eligible.

Students must first obtain a faculty mentor, who will assist in the choice of a topic, completion of the proposal form, and pursuit and completion of the proposed project.

Application deadline February 12.

Presentation Travel Grants

Showcase your research and represent the University of Tennessee at a regional, national, or international conference. We are pleased to announce the addition of an <u>Undergraduate Research Travel Grants</u> program to our program offerings.

Students presenting their work at conferences may apply for funds to partially defray the costs of registration and travel. The amounts

awarded are:

- •\$300 for regional conferences (TN and any contiguous state)
- •\$500 for national conferences
- •\$800 for international conferences



Research in Jordan this Summer

The 'Ayn Gharandal Archaeological Project and Dig Jordan program will bring students to the Middle East July 2019 to conduct archaeological and cultural heritage research. Students work closely with Erin Darby (Religious Studies), Robert Darby (School of Art), and the project research staff. No prior research experience in field collection or laboratory analysis needed.

Scholarships available from CIE and professional organizations like the American Schools of Oriental Research, the American Center of Oriental Research, and the Archaeological Institute of America.

EXPLORE - Research Assistant Posting Database

Are you looking for undergraduate research opportunities?

Use EXPLORE to search for faculty by academic department, view open oncampus research positions, and view off-campus research opportunities.

Log in to <u>ugexplore.utk.edu</u> using your UT NetID and search and apply for



positions. Keep checking, we post new openings frequently.



R-designation

Look for classes with the Research (R) designation in the course catalog. These courses have undergraduate research built into the course. You can also ask your department or advisor if there are any R-courses available for you. The R-designation

will appear on your transcript allowing confirmation of participation.



Submit Undergraduate Research Highlights for the next issue of Scholarship and Practice of Undergraduate Research. Undergraduate Research Highlights briefly describe peer-reviewed research or scholarly work in academic journals, book and book chapters, Web-based publications, and juried performances that have occurred within the past six months. They must be in print and must have one or more undergraduate coauthors. Email your submission to <u>ugresearch@utk.edu</u>.
