We are beginning to fill our open staff positions for the 2022-23 school year. Over the last year we have grown by 100 students and have our usual need for replacements due to departures and retirements. Hiring and finding experienced educators is harder than it has ever been.

Most recently we have actually filled all of our available classified positions (6 total) all with EVHS alumni. Our local talent pool is doing great things for us right now. Outside of that we have struggled to find many qualified applicants for our most critical job roles. We are already experiencing that for our certified positions we are finding mostly 1st year teachers, alternative licensure candidates, and professionals from other countries.

We are hoping to reach out through our parent community to advertise and search for the quality teachers we need right now. Our ability to fill these positions will allow us to maintain our smaller class sizes, varied course offerings, and teacher plan time during the day.
