Slonin, Riley Cummins, Eva Slonin, Zane Price, Anna Vitale, and Wesley Hsia.



Arts Center at Stuart High School - Project Update

On Tuesday March 2, at a workshop meeting of the Martin County School Board, school board members authorized School Board Chairperson Marsha Powers and Superintendent Dr. John Millay to work with us to gain access to the buildings on the site for pre-construction evaluation. The evaluation will be coordinated by Straticon Construction and supported by Jeff & Chris Hardin. We are grateful for their expertise as we begin to move the project forward.
