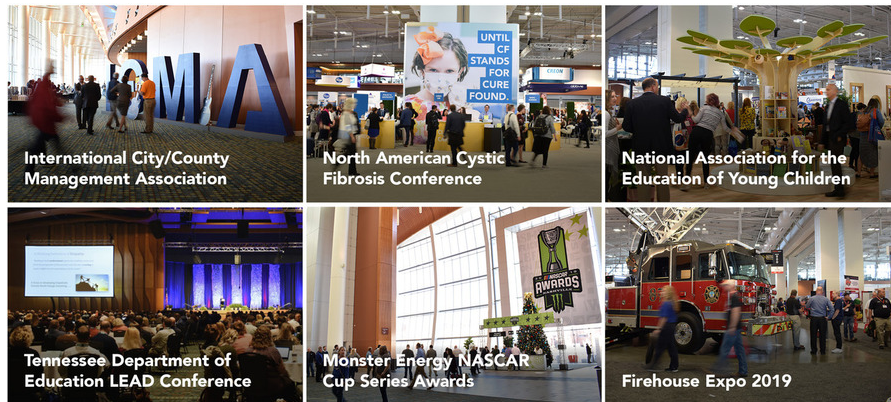


**From the President/CEO**
