Celebrating UChicago's Nobel Laureates 2024

This year, **Professor James A. Robinson**, a UChicago economist and political scientist, has been awarded the Sveriges Riksbank Prize in Economic Sciences in Memory of Alfred Nobel 2024 for his research on the root causes of global inequality, including the pivotal roles of institutions.

UChicago alumnus **John Jumper**, SM'12, PhD'17, and the co-inventor of the Al model AlphaFold, was also awarded the Nobel Prize in Chemistry for helping crack the code of protein structures.

They are the 100th and 101st members of the UChicago community to earn a Nobel Prize. Congratulations to Professor Robinson and Dr. Jumper!
