NORTH CITY IN SAN MARCOS

San Marcos has big news! North City, a mixed-use development project spanning nearly 200 acres, is well on its way to becoming the area's central hub and latest downtown destination. According to the developer, Sea Breeze Properties, this project



includes "...3,400 residential units, 250 hotel rooms, 1,100,000 SF of office, and 345,000 SF of retail." The Quad, an 866-bed student housing building, was the first North City project to see completion.

Pardon our dust while we are under construction: The San Diego International Airport's NEW Terminal 1 project is underway! The original Terminal 1 opened in 1967 with only 2.5 million passengers either leaving or arriving during its first year of being open. Now,

there are over 11 million people annually that utilize this terminal. The new Administration Building is scheduled to open in late 2023, with the parking plaza opening in 2024 and Phase 1 of Terminal 1 to open in late 2025!




