(Omaha, Nebraska) – The Nebraska Arts Council (NAC) is seeking nominations for the upcoming Governors Arts Awards (GAA), which will take place on Friday, March 27th at the State Capitol building, in the Rotunda. NAC has announced a new GAA award, the Access to the Arts award, which honors individuals or organizations that have made a significant impact of accessibility to the arts. The deadline for GAA award nominations is Friday, Dec. 13, 2019.
