Call for Dual Degree Ph.D. Programs

Open Call for up to 6 CMU Portugal Dual Degree Ph.D. Scholarships

The Carnegie Mellon Portugal Program and Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia (FCT), have an **open Call for up to 6 Dual Degree Ph.D. scholarships to start in the 2023/2024 academic year in ICT related areas.**

The applications are currently open and must be submitted online directly at CMU. Application deadlines vary according to each one of the seven Ph.D. Programs available.

CMU Portugal has a new call to bootstrap new Exploratory projects in ICT

The Carnegie Mellon Portugal Program has an Open Call from October 11th, 2022 through November 17th, 2022 for Exploratory Research Projects (ERPs) in strategic emerging areas of ICT, funded through the Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia (FCT). This is the third Call for ERPs since the Program started its 3rd phase in 2018. ERPs are an initiative focused on bootstrapping high-impact potential research activities between Portuguese Institutions and Carnegie Mellon University (CMU).

It is expected that up to 8 projects will be supported, with the maximum funding for Portuguese research institutions for each project being €70.000,00 euros for consortia with more than one Portuguese research institution and 50.000,00 for consortium with a single research institution. This typology of projects is planned for a maximum duration of 12 months, starting in 2023.

Under this initiative funded by Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia (FCT), students will be entirely hosted by a Portuguese University, with a research period at Carnegie Mellon of up to one year. Upon the Ph.D. conclusion, the Portuguese host University will award candidates a Ph.D. diploma.
