**Residential Life - Winter Break Check Out:** Residence halls close over winter break. Your Tiger is expected to vacate their room within 24-hours of their last exam, or by 8 p.m. on December 11, 2021, whichever comes first. They do not need to completely move out of their room when they check out, but they should bring what they'll need with them as they won't have access to their space until January 2022.

If your Tiger has a late final exam or extenuating travel arrangements, they may request an extension to remain in their room until 12 p.m. on Sunday, December 12. They can email their community's **Residence Coordinator** to request an extension by noon on Friday, December 10, 2021... **[read more]**.


Shots for Socks! Students can receive a free pair of LSU socks, when they get their flu vaccine at the Student Health Center, while supplies last. With flu cases on the rise on campus, urge your Tiger to get vaccinated TODAY! Appointments are not necessary; however, to expedite the process, students are strongly encouraged to upload their insurance card prior to presenting for their vaccine. Students should bring an LSU ID, an insurance card and a form of payment (if applicable). Most insurance plans will cover the full
