I recall road trips during college that depended on far too much coffee and far too little stopping along the way to stretch, hydrate, refocus, and check-in. Remind them to pace themselves and prioritize safety along the way. When they arrive at their destination, it's important to reinforce conversations you've had with them about alcohol use – particularly those that remind them never to leave a drink unattended or accept one from a stranger. Spring break exists because we understand that burnout and stress are real. The more they can rest and relax, the more prepared they will be to finish the semester strong.

Course scheduling begins on March 27, so now is the time for students to start thinking about their fall courses and planning to stay on track for timely graduation. It's always a good idea for them to meet with their academic advisor for scheduling and assistance as they plan their course load.

During their college career, so many situations arise that will be entirely beyond your student's control. However, if they control the things they can (as mentioned above), it will make all the unexpected bumps in the road a little easier to navigate. As always, we have resources and are here to assist at every step.

LSU Campus Life: Tiger Twelve Applications Are Open

Each spring, LSU recognizes 12 outstanding seniors who contribute positively to the life of the campus, surrounding community, and society. These 12 individuals are recognized as the Tiger Twelve. The application period is now open on TigerLink through March 13 and we invite all eligible students to apply. <u>Apply here!</u>

Tiger Twelve Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the Tiger Twelve Class of 2022, a student must:

- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5
- Be an undergraduate student graduating in May, August, or December of 2022
- Have current full-time status at LSU (unless graduating in May 2022). Includes students participating in student teaching, co-ops, and academically sponsored programs.
- Be in good academic and accountability standing. Having an accountability record will not automatically disqualify a student from becoming a Tiger Twelve awardee.

Center For Academic Success: The Center for Academic Success helps students be their academic best. Encourage your Tiger to use our services - attend our **workshops**, schedule an appointment with an **academic coach**, seek out **course support**, visit the **CAS website** for online resources. CAS services help students earn higher grades and discover more effective study strategies.

<u>Math Strategy Workshops</u> - Another workshop added on Wednesday, March 9 from 3-4 p.m. on Zoom. This workshop targets resources and effective strategies for students enrolled in Math 1021, 1022, and 1029. Students must register on Navigate.


