A NOTE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear LSU Families,

I'm extremely impressed and immensely proud of the entire LSU community for the way it has responded to the COVID-19



pandemic, from the speed and adeptness with which our students and faculty transitioned to online classes, to our researchers and medical professionals who have been fighting on the front lines to save lives. It has been nothing short of a Herculean effort, set against the backdrop of unprecedented circumstances, and I am constantly inspired by the way everyone is pulling together to keep LSU moving forward.

But like our students, faculty and staff, I'm ready to get back to campus.
