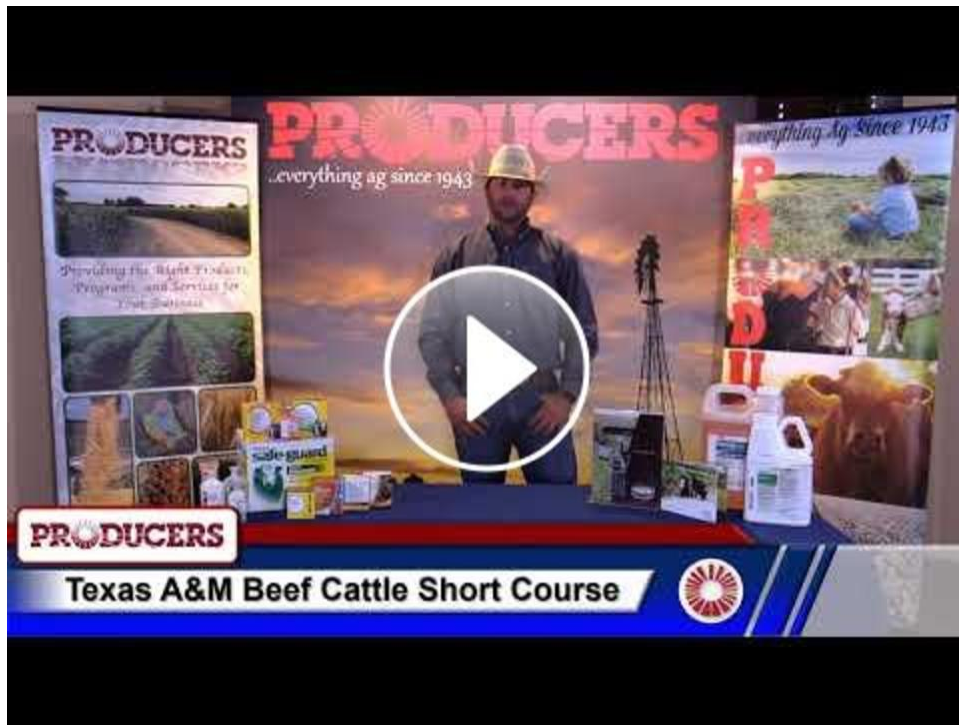
Route Delivery Available
