I am so happy to announce the appointment of Najiba Akbar as Tufts University's new Muslim Chaplain. In this role, Najiba will advise and support students active in the Muslim Student Association (MSA) and across Tufts' campuses; offer programs that celebrate and explore the cultural and spiritual diversity of the Muslim community; provide pastoral care; and work alongside the University Chaplaincy team and campus partners on various interfaith, intercultural, social justice, and anti-racism initiatives. She will begin her role on November 12, 2021.

Najiba comes to Tufts with years of leadership and programming experience in higher education and credits her own years of spiritual formation as an undergraduate for her passion for accompanying students as they explore and claim their own spiritual identities and practices. She served as Muslim Chaplain at Wellesley College from 2008 – 2012 and is currently Muslim Advisor at Northeastern University. She is a trained personal development coach and has been an Islamic Studies instructor at the Islamic Center of Boston. Najiba is also a skilled dialogue facilitator and served as a program co-facilitator for Tufts' Pathways interfaith dialogue initiative from 2007 – 2009.
