additions to the Tiger family or they are counting down to graduation, the entire LSU faculty and staff community stand ready to assist them as they pursue their academic and career goals. Also, regardless of where your student is in their LSU journey, we are eager to establish or continue our relationship



with you as partners in their success.

We know a solid partnership with you is critical to your student's LSU experience. Family support matters—but not so much support that students are not empowered to stand on their own. While their journey to independence might not be complete, we hope we can work together to transition them to a mindset of interdependence, where they become their own best advocates, navigate complexity, make important decisions, and take responsibility for their success. Your support is vital during this transition time, but it might look different than in the past. If you have concerns about their health or safety, please contact us directly and as soon as possible. We will work with you to connect them to the appropriate resources. However, as they handle roommate conflicts, forge relationships with professors, learn from conduct situations, or navigate other facets of the university experience, we encourage you to empower them to take the lead. This will allow them to create invaluable interpersonal skills. We also hope you will frequently remind them what is in their control to solve. We are ready, willing, and able to support them as they develop this skill set.

Finally, I wanted to provide you with a <u>pdf version</u> of the book "Becoming a Learner." This is a quick read, but it is a treasure trove of wisdom about making the most of one's college experience. This book serves as the framework for our <u>Welcome Week</u> experience (August 14-21) and for multiple experiences your student will encounter during the year.

We couldn't be more excited for the beginning of a new academic year—and we are so glad you and your student are members of the LSU family.

**LSU Ambassadors:** LSU Ambassadors is an organization that aids and represents the University by serving students and families. Students interested in encouraging and promoting spirit and unity among LSU and Baton Rouge communities can attend one of the following **interest meetings** on Monday, August 29th and Tuesday, August 30th. There will be two sessions on each day held in 130 Howe Russell from 6-7 p.m. and 7-8 p.m. These are informal meetings to give prospective members an idea about our organization's purpose and the selections process to becoming an LSU Ambassador. We hope to see your Tiger there!

**Bursar Operations:** Fall 2022 Fee Bills are available on MyLSU and can be viewed through MyLSU > Registration Services. The Fall 2022 registration payment due date is August 19 to avoid classes being purged. For students that select the Deferred Payment Plan for Fall 2022, the first payment will be due October 1st. Payments are considered late after Monday, October 10th.

**Center for Academic Success:** Spark Your Success at LSU! Is your student prepared for the Fall semester? The Center for Academic Success offers free academic and learning support services for LSU students, including academic coaching, Supplemental Instruction, tutoring, workshops, and online resources. **LSU Food Pantry:** The LSU Food Pantry provides supplemental food to students who may experience hunger or food insecurity. It is open Monday through Friday and is available to all currently enrolled students. Orders are placed online and students choose a pickup time. The pantry is also always looking for volunteers. **Free Scantrons and Bluebooks:** LSU Student Government (SG) provides several free (yes, free!) academic resources to all students. These include free testing materials such as scantrons and bluebooks, as well as free printing. All of this is available in room 150 on the

first floor of the Student Union. Please let your Tiger know to stop by to utilize these resources and to find out what else SG has to offer!

Freshman Leadership Council: Is your freshman interested in being a leader, finding their niche, and making new friends on campus? Freshman Leadership Council (FLC) provides incoming freshmen with opportunities to learn more about leadership through the lens of LSU Student Government. FLC members are paired with upperclassmen Small Group Leaders who mentor members to step up and lead on campus, while helping to make the most of their first-year experience. **Mailing Services:** The UPS Store housed in the LSU Student Union is here for all your Tiger's mailing and shipping needs. All students living on campus should have received their LSU Box number assignment via their LSU email. All USPS mail and non-perishable courier delivered packages (Amazon, UPS, FedEx, etc.) should be shipped to this box using this address format:

When the student receives mail or packages, they will be alerted via email to come to the UPS Store in the Union to pick it up. Please be aware that USPS tracking shows delivery to Baton Rouge, not to the UPS Store. It can take an extra 1-2 days to reach our campus store.

**LSU Olinde Career Center:** Take full advantage of this exciting time with your student! Starting or returning to college can be fun and exciting, but also a bit intimidating. Parents and families can start the conversation now by asking important questions about major and

Student Employment: As your Tigers come back to campus this month, LSU's Student Employment Office wants your help in reminding students to bring important documents needed for working on or off-campus. All student employees must provide <a href="mailto:acceptable">acceptable</a>
documentation to their employers to show their identity and authorization to work. If your Tiger is still looking for a job on campus, we are here to help! **Student Health Center:** Help your Tiger navigate their health care at LSU and encourage them to join a virtual Insurance Forum hosted by the Student Health Center. **Student Support Services:** Is your first-generation student receiving the support they need? Encourage them to apply to **Student Support Services**! We are a federal grant that serves first-generation students, income-eligible, and students with disabilities. The priority deadline for the fall 2022 cohort has passed. Applications will open on October 1 for the spring 2023 cohort.
