System and Tools Deprecation Notice: Permanent Budget System and Online Transfer of Funds (OLTF)

As previously communicated, the Permanent Budget & Staffing System and the Online Transfer of Funds System (OLTF) have been deprecated as of July 1st, 2020. Historical budget and staffing data as well as OLTF information will continue to be accessible via the BudgetLink application.

Deprecation and Alternatives

Previously termed Permanent Budget, now called Recurring Budget, starting with fiscal year 2021 and beyond will be available within the Oracle Planning and Budgeting Cloud Service (EPBCS). EPBCS budgets will be used to seed the total budget in Oracle Financials Cloud (OFC) General Ledger.

There is no replacement for the OLTF tool as budgets are no longer transactional and represent a financial plan. The OLTF tool is now replaced with financial journal entries in the Oracle General Ledger.

The campus is excited to announce the upcoming release of Oracle Planning and Budgeting in late **January 2021!** This new system will make way for a bottom-up budget development for UC San Diego delivering a thoughtful design and uniformity across budgeting moving forward.

With Oracle Planning and Budgeting, you will be able to perform web based entries for core and other campus unrestricted funds planning serving as a comprehensive budget plan.

Oracle Planning and Budgeting User Role and Access

Preliminary Budget Users have been identified and will be provisioned access to the system for upcoming training beginning late January. Budget Users are those assigned by their department with responsibility to create and manage financial unit budgets. We are actively working with your Vice Chancellor Office to assign access.
