For our American clients, we hope you had a super Thanksgiving.

I just returned from East Africa, where I visited the under-construction JW Marriott Masai Mara in Kenya and then the TopGuides Lolkisale Camp in Tanzania's Tarangire National Park.

The **JW Marriott Masai Mara** is coming along well and opening is scheduled for March 31, 2023. It's an amazing site with lovely views across the Mara. The tents, bathrooms, Jacuzzis, kitchen, pool and spa are almost finished, and the crew is working on the finishing touches. We have 17 standard tents (largest in Kenya), one honeymoon tent and a huge family tent. All rooms offer views of the Talek River and some also have views of a new manmade waterhole in the reserve (two hippos have already moved in!). While the camp is not yet listed on the JW Marriott website, our Nairobi team is already taking reservations for high season.

I also stayed at the **Crowne Plaza Nairobi Airport**. In addition to being very convenient to the airport terminal (just four minutes), they have a terrific spa and a rooftop pool and bar. If guests are arriving late or need a day room, I highly recommend it.

Now to **Lolkisale Camp** in Tarangire. In a word: "Wow!" It's situated by the Silale Swamp with great views of the surrounding savannah. It's in a really quiet part of the park — except for all of the wildlife passing by — elephants, zebras, buffalo, impalas. And we had amorous lions close by. Take a look at this gorgeous camp [here](#). Unfortunately, the TopGuides mobile camp was moving locations, so I'll visit that next time.
