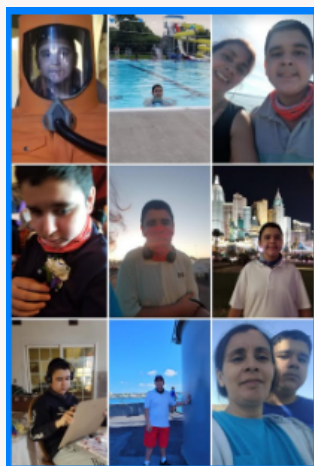
Easter Egg Hunt & Potluck - All Are Welcome

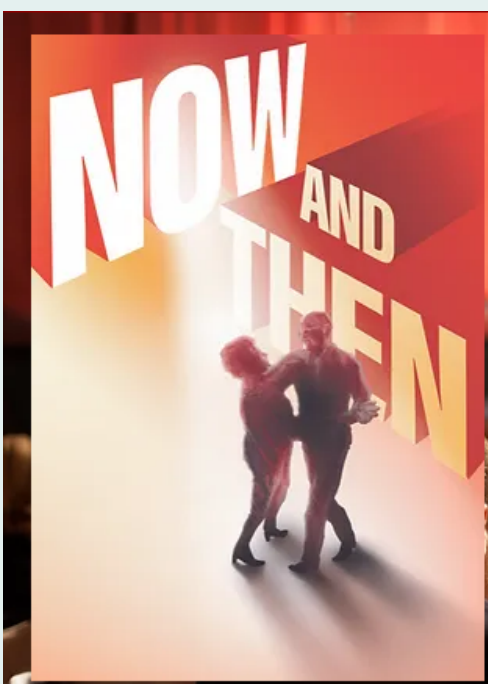

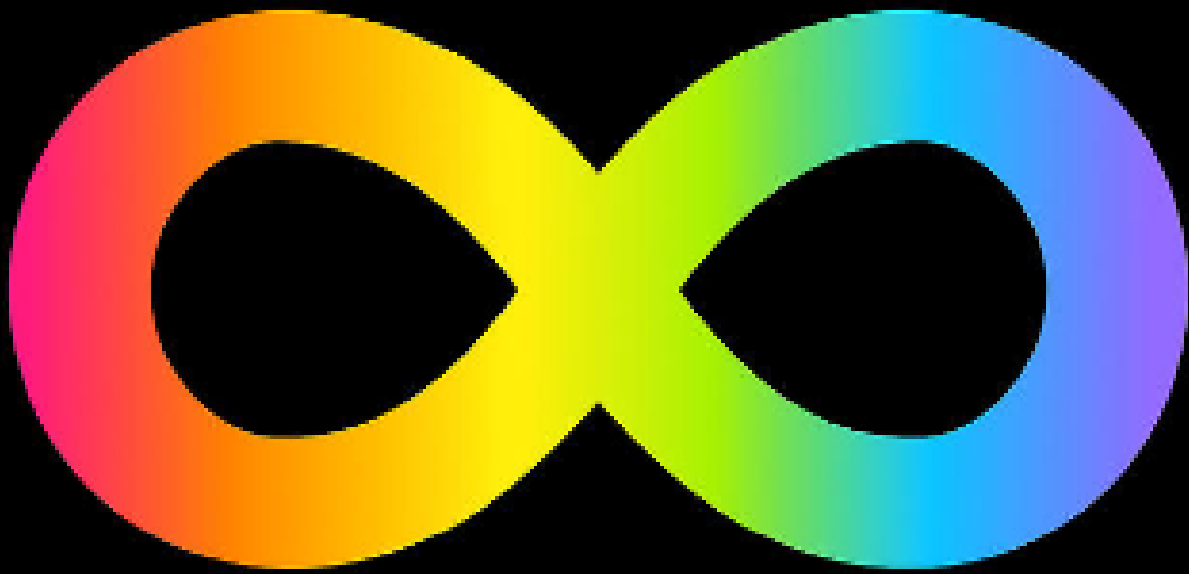
