Thursday, July 25 | 8:00am MDT

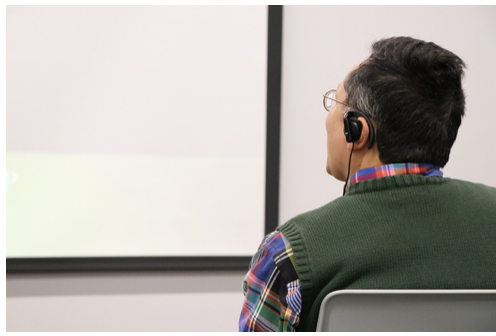

New Arts Accessibility Grant for improvement projects

The Nebraska Arts Council is pleased to announce a new grant category: Arts Accessibility Grant for improvement projects. This grant program is designed to provide up to \$5,000 in non-matching funds to art organizations for projects that improve access to their existing programs or facilities for patrons with disabilities.

Besides improvement to facilities, other eligible projects include the purchase of, and staff training for, accessibility equipment and professional development for staff and artists on how to improve the accessibility of existing programs.
