and ranked No. 8 worldwide? As I write this letter, Chile has already vaccinated 20% of its

population!

Those numbers — together with remote and uncrowded landscapes like Torres del Paine National Park — make Chile a prime choice if you're looking for an international destination for your clients. Las Torres Reserve has already set reopening dates for the upcoming season and will start welcoming travelers again very soon.
