

What's required?

- 3 short essays: Statement of Purpose; Impact essay; Service project proposal
- Unofficial transcript and Advisors certifications

- Selecting a Host County for the Fulbright U.S. Student Program on March 9 at 6:00 p.m. PT- The Fulbright U.S. Student Program offers fully funded research, study and teaching opportunities in over 140 countries to recent graduates and graduate students with U.S. citizenship. In this webinar, ONIF will provide tips and advice for selecting a host country for your Fulbright year. Whether you are interested in teaching English abroad, pursuing a one-year master's, or conducting independent research; the right host county is essential to the application process. LMU undergraduate and graduate students of all majors are invited to learn more about host country options for the 2023-2024 program.
- <u>Berlin Capital Journalism Program</u>- Deadline: March 21. In 2022, the Berlin Capital Program invites early-career U.S. journalists and journalism students to Germany. The weeklong seminar allows participants to take a closer look at the German media landscape and gain a deeper awareness of German and European society. It includes meetings, visits, discussions and workshops with German and expat members of the media, experts in various fields, government officials, and engaged citizens. The journalists will enhance their understanding of transatlantic issues, expand their professional perspectives and networks, and gain insights to better "translate" the news from one side of the Atlantic to the other. The program, conducted in English, is operated by and fully funded through Fulbright Germany. An eligible applicant must
 - hold U.S. American citizenship and a valid U.S. passport as prerequisites, and permanently reside in the U.S. Applicants with dual (German-American) citizenship are not eligible to apply.

- be a U.S.-based professional journalist, currently working for U.S. media (as an employee or independent journalist) in the U.S., with fewer than 5 years of work experience in the field,
- or be a Master's student (at the time of application) in the field of journalism or communications at a U.S. university,
- or be a graduating senior (at the time of application) in the field of journalism or communications at a U.S. university.
- demonstrate relevant background and professional interests.
- Freeman-ASIA Study Abroad Scholarship- Deadline: March 29.

Provides need-based funding of up to \$7,000 for study abroad programs (summer, fall, or spring) of at least 8-weeks in Cambodia, China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Laos, Macao, Malaysia, Mongolia, Philippines, Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand, and Vietnam.
