This month my FRESH TRAYS team offered our first local food procurement training for Child Nutrition Program operators. More than 20 nutrition professionals joined TDA at the Region 6 Education Service Center in Huntsville to learn more about how to identify and source local products while ensuring compliance with federal, state, and local regulations. The training is designed to provide the knowledge and skills needed to increase the number of local foods purchased and enhance agricultural education for program participants.

There are 20 of these training events scheduled for future dates across Texas. In your December E-Harvest I told you about the FRESH TRAYS training for agricultural producers launched in collaboration with Texas A&M AgriLife. These training opportunities are integral to my Farm Fresh Initiative and will keep Texas leading the way in connecting nutrition programs and agriculture.

It was used in all of the Crawford ISD beef meals for the 2024-2025 school year. It was so well received by the kids, specifically the burgers, that the school changed their burger supplier for their football games. Barnard Beef also donated beef to both the Parent Teacher Organization cookoff fundraiser and the band's Taco Day as well as various other fundraisers. "
