 - Reykjavik Pride (August): A vibrant celebration of LGBTQ+ culture and rights, Reykjavik
 Pride includes a parade, concerts, parties, and cultural events, drawing large crowds and
 fostering a spirit of inclusivity and acceptance.
 - **Reykjavik Culture Night (August)**: This event marks the beginning of the city's cultural year, featuring a day and night of cultural activities, including art exhibitions, concerts, dance performances, and fireworks. It's a family-friendly event attracting both locals and tourists.
