It actually feels good to put out there something that we want to address that is part of our normal operations. We regularly have one quarter of our student population show up late to the first period (which is 250 students). This pattern was happening well before COVID and lateness seems to be ingrained in the pace of life living in the mountains. As an administrator I have some strong professional feelings about timeliness. However, I know that not all of my own values or personal expectations make good policies. So after more than a decade of trying to reinforce the importance of being to school and class on time as important, maybe it is me that needs to change and adapt to the cultural norms.



is Saturday, April 30th at the Hythe Resort in Lionshead Village in Vail, CO. The dance is from 8:00-11:00 PM. We wanted to send out a few



reminders about Prom 2022. We are happy to note we do not have any Covid restrictions in place and that we do not have a limit on the number of students who can attend the event.

If an EVHS Junior or Senior plans on taking a date who is an underclassman, a student who attends a different high school, or is a recent graduate, they will need to complete and submit a <u>Dance Guest Request Form</u>. Forms are located in the front office and are **due Thursday**, **April 28th to Ms.**Wiens, (no exceptions). Forms need to be fully completed, by both schools, before they are submitted to the front office.

Prom tickets will go on sale Monday, April 25th and will be sold through Friday, April 29th. We will not sell tickets at the dance unless prior approval was granted by Administration or Mr. Little. Tickets will be sold outside the front office during A and B lunches, before school, and after school. Individual tickets cost \$45. Students will nominate royalty, and will place song requests, when they purchase their ticket. Voting for Prom King and Queen will take place at the dance. Drinks and dessert will be served at the dance.

The Hythe will offer valet parking for \$10 the night of the dance to attendees of the EVHS Prom. Students may also park at the Lionshead parking structure.

We are beyond pleased to announce that Victoria Aragon (Eagle Valley High School), the daughter of Armando Aragon and Aracely Marioni, has been named a 2022 Boettcher Scholar, a scholarship program that provides financial support to a Colorado College/University along with leadership and networking opportunities. Boettcher looks for the top students in Colorado. Victoria has been a phenomenal leader/mentor/advocate/(the list goes on) in this school/community and is extremely deserving of this honor.

Since 1952, the Boettcher Foundation has awarded more than \$100 million in undergraduate scholarships to Colorado's most dynamic young minds, doers, and difference-makers (Boettcher Foundation, 2019). More than 1,500 students apply to be named one of 50 Boettcher Scholars annually. Victoria was chosen as one of the prestigious Boettcher recipients due to her work with Tu Guia, My Future Pathways, YouthPower365, a weighted GPA of 4.31, and an intensive interview process. Should Victoria choose to attend an in-state college, she will receive an annual amount of \$20,00 per year from Boettcher for four years. Once again, Congratulations Victoria!
