CME Funds Alert!

Business Travel has been banned until further notice due to the COVID-19 Virus pandemic.

First, this may cause some people an issue in that they will now have a challenge spending their CME funds before the funds expire on June, 30, 2020. To handle that problem, Department Leadership has decided to allow the rollover of CME fund balances into FY21. Yea!

Second, there will be a couple of issues concerning refunds of reimbursed expenses, like conference fees and airline tickets.

- 1. **Conference fees:** If you have been reimbursed and then you are issued a credit onto your personal credit card by the conference, you will need to write a personal check to VUMC and give it to your administrative assistant. Your AA will then debit your CME fund and give the check to Ms. Rosalia Gaudino for deposit.
- 2. **Airline tickets:** The most likely thing the airline will do is give you a ticket/credit to be used in the future. The department's expectation is that you will use the ticket for business travel, once the travel restrictions are lifted. In the event that you get a credit made to a personal credit card, see number 1.

Ultrasound Update

We recently received new Mindray ultrasounds in the main OR, periop, and VSC. Placing a Tegaderm directly to probe surface interferes with the probe functionality, creating fuzzy, dampened images and drop out. We are recommending that you either:

- 1) Apply a small bead of gel to the probe before placing a Tegaderm
- 2) Use a probe cover with gel inside

This is a change to our current practice, but would actually bring us in line with current industry standards. We are going to evaluate some alternative probe covers to be used for basic blocks, but until then please use the probe coverage as above, at least for the Mindray ultrasounds, ideally for all ultrasound use.


