The Colorado Family Fund awards \$2,500 and The Jana Marie Lambert Memorial awards \$1,500. You will be considered for both awards per one application.

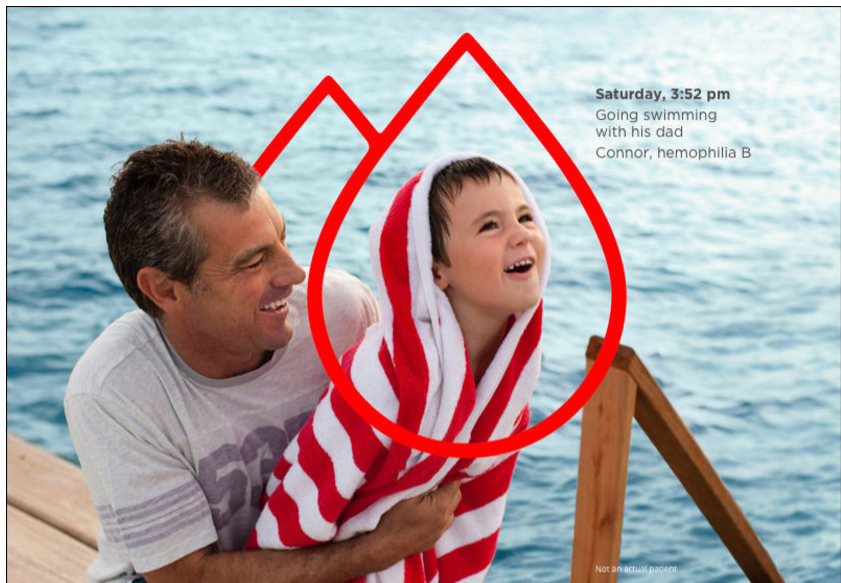
