David Szikman (Class of 1986) - David is the owner/operator of Sandy Springs Music, established in 2004. He was born in Montreal and at the age of 4, his family moved to Atlanta and enrolled him in Kindergarten at The Epstein School the following fall. David has been in numerous bands and performed as a solo artist in Arizona, Alabama, Colorado, and Atlanta. He has been lucky enough to the at the right place at the right time; his band had the opportunity to open one day at the Aspen Jazz Festival in 1998 and they were followed by Taj Mahal, Keb Mo, and Crosby, Stills & Nash.

After spending a few years in Aspen, David moved back to Atlanta and shortly after, opened his own music teaching studio, Sandy Springs Music. Since then, he



has been dedicated to not only providing the best music lessons, instrument rentals and retail possible, but also to bringing the Sandy Springs music community together. Paula A. Freedman, Psy.D. (Class of 2002) - Paula is currently a licensed Clinical Psychologist at Interaction Dynamics in Chicago, Illinois and has written a book entitled, *The Addiction Recovery Workbook - Powerful Skills For Preventing Relapse Every Day*. Dr.

Freedman specializes in addictive, anxiety and eating disorders; the book she has written is a self-help style resource, using current research and evidence-based tools to decrease the likelihood for relapse, and was inspired by her work helping individuals recover. Although it is written for those recovering from substance use disorders, the information and skills are widely applicable to struggles with eating disorders and behavioral addictions and self-harm.



As long as she can remember, even when she was a little girl attending The Epstein School, she wanted to be an author. She proudly and boldly announced her desire to be an author to her 2nd grade class and her favorite teacher, **Mrs. Harriet Litzsky**, who always complimented her on her writing and reading skills. Paula stated that the quality of her Epstein education foundation was excellent and helped set her up for success. Dr. Freedman is grateful for the Hebrew education she received and is confident that learning another language at an early age enhanced her language skills and verbal processing. In 2010, she completed her bachelor's degree in communications and sociology at American University in Washington, DC. Judah Kerbel (Class of 2005) is finishing rabbinical school at the Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary, affiliated with Yeshiva University. This year, he is also a Beit Midrash Fellow at SAR High School in Riverdale in New York, where he teaches Tanakh (Bible) and Talmud with small groups of students throughout the day. After graduating from Epstein, Judah attended The Weber School and spent a year on Nativ in Israel; during those years, he was heavily involved in USY.

He studied Jewish studies and psychology at the University of Maryland, where he held leadership positions in the Orthodox community and the Student Government Association. His majors and leadership



opportunities ultimately influenced him to pursue a career in the rabbinate, to be engaged with the intellectual, pastoral, and leadership elements that make a career in the rabbinate so meaningful. Following college, Judah studied at Yeshivat Har Etzion in Alon Shevut, Israel, before enrolling in YU. In addition to rabbinic studies, Judah earned a master's degree in

Medieval Jewish History and completed advanced coursework in mental health counseling in a program oriented towards aspiring rabbis. During his years in rabbinical school, Judah participated in fellowships through AIPAC, UJA-Federation of New York, the Center for Modern Torah Leadership, and Fellowships at Auschwitz for the Study of Professional Ethics. Judah credits The Epstein School with imparting a love of Judaism and Israel that remains with him to this day and impacted his decision to become a rabbi, as well as rigorous secular and Judaic studies that gave him the tools to do so. Judah and his wife Eliana, a 5th grade teacher at Yeshivat He'Atid in Teaneck, New Jersey, live in Manhattan.

JoJo Meyers (Class of 2009) - After graduating Epstein, JoJo attended The Weber School and graduated in 2013. Immediately following high school, he made Aliyah and shortly after, enlisted in the Israeli Air Force Flight (IAF) Academy. Two of his passions drove and motivated him to make that decision: He has always been fascinated by aviation and has always loved and believed strongly in the protection of Israel. JoJo is currently a Lieutenant in the IAF and serves as a drone pilot and mission commander in the "First Zik Squadron" at Palmachim Airbase. The drone division is very interesting to him, but it has its own set of challenges and dilemmas. On a regular basis, they perform missions in highly populated areas and often have to make very consequential decisions that can greatly affect the outcome on the ground.



JoJo is also an officer in the Gaza Branch of the Air Force Planning Directorate. He lives in Tel Aviv and plans to begin university studies in the fields of psychology and economics soon. JoJo notes that Epstein played a big role in cultivating his love for the State of Israel and that his favorite memory from his time spent here is the 8th grade trip to Israel. In his time off, he enjoys reading, cooking, and traveling.

Throughout Ariel's four years at Weber, she has been actively involved and held leadership positions in various community, school, and athletic activities. For example, she has been an active Board member of Friendship Circle, responsible for organizing group activities and planning lessons for individuals with special needs. At Weber, Ariel was a mentor through the Peer Leadership program, meeting with her assigned group of freshman to mentor and assist their transition into high school. She was also on the Board of Girl Talk, a mentoring program for the Epstein School and Davis Academy's seventh and eighth grade girls.



After completing years of gymnastics, Epstein's Athletics Director, Jim Battoglia (Coach B), encouraged Ariel to try pole vaulting.
