- Brenton Melton, Denny Nelson, Tony White, Ben Kruppenbacher, Richard Ridgeway, Wilson Smith, Ann Prunuske, Jeri Anderson, and Troy Miller joined our <u>Advisory Board</u>. And, in February 2019, Jolene and Kyle Lloyd joined too.
- And, Marie Grimm, Elizabeth Varnes, Michele Wodey, Lori Bailey, Patricia Reiss, Ashley Morigeau, and Kendra Ferrera became our first volunteers.
   And, in February 2019, Bill Gravely, Katrina Guenther, Kristi Harper, and Tanara Sesera, joined our team too.
- Lastly, YOU did an awesome job in financially supporting Whitetail by donating more than \$22,500.

The Whitetail Ranch Center Board of Directors thanks you for your tremendous passion to make Whitetail a reality. We could not have gotten this far without **YOU**.

Earlier this week, you should have received our announcement regarding our partnership with *Operation Never Forgotten*. Whitetail will be able to extend its reach through a national presence, grow our capacity, expand our network, grow our donor base, seek partnered grant opportunities, and bring celebrity endorsements to Whitetail. This is an incredible opportunity for Whitetail as we move forward into 2019. We will be pursuing two major projects this year.

- We have been approved for an <u>AmeriCorp VISTA Member</u> to help manage our daily communication and grow our capacity. This is a fulltime position in our Three Forks office. We are responsible for a portion of the VISTA member's income and for providing a full-work station. We need to raise \$9700.00 by July.
- We have been able to identify properties in Madison, Jefferson, and Broadwater Counties that are for sale and align with Whitetail's needs. However, land owners/sellers want to see more money in our bank account and those with deep pockets want to see a land contract prior to making a substantial donation. Therefore, the Whitetail Board of Directors has set a goal to raise \$300,000.00 to acquire a land contract.

You might be asking yourself how will we make this happen? With your help we can reach our goals. Our volunteer board of directors, volunteer advisory board, and volunteers cannot keep up with the growth Whitetail is incurring without YOU! 
