In the meantime, preventing the transmission of COVID-19 on our campus must remain our top priority, and we have implemented enhanced testing efforts and wastewater analysis to better protect our students, faculty, and staff. We have also established a COVID-19 call center at 225-427-1326 to address any questions or concerns from our campus community. And we are working in coordination with the Louisiana Department of Health and other state agencies to begin administering vaccinations on campus as soon as they become available to us, which we expect to happen in the coming months.

To better help our students overcome any potential obstacles that may stand in the way of their graduation, we have established the **Student Success Help Desk** in the Student Welcome Center at the corner of Dalrymple Drive and Highland Road. The help desk is open Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m., and it can be reached by phone at 225-578-2634 or by email at **success@lsu.edu**. We are also encouraging faculty to hold virtual office hours or synchronous remote classes as often as possible, and Student Affairs is working to create additional opportunities for students to engage with their friends this spring.

We continue to develop new initiatives and explore changes to improve Title IX reporting and enforcement on campus; make reporting sexual assault and violence as straightforward a process as possible; provide better and more sensitive support to victims, and find ways to prevent sexual assault from happening in the first place. This important work is being done with input from students, faculty, and staff, as well as external partners such as the Baton Rouge Sexual Trauma Awareness and Response Center. We are building an ongoing relationship with STAR, and we will be working with them throughout this year on some new initiatives, including strengthening our training of everyone on campus and enhancing victim support.

Meanwhile, Husch Blackwell continues to conduct its independent investigation of our handling of sexual assault and abuse cases, and they're also working on a comprehensive review of our Title IX reporting processes and policy implementation. We expect to have a report from them later this month, we will be sharing their findings publicly, and we will not hesitate to take swift and appropriate disciplinary action relating to our employees if it's warranted.

As we celebrate Black History Month on campus throughout February, we also continue to make progress on our work to implement the action items in our Diversity & Inclusion Roadmap. LSU students, faculty, staff, alumni, and administrators convened for our second Inclusion, Equity, and Diversity Leadership Retreat

Parking & Transportation Services: Please be advised that all parking rules and regulations are in full effect. All student vehicles are required to park their vehicle in their correct zone, in an authorized parking space, and must display the proper permit in the windshield of their vehicle. If your Tiger needs a permit, an annual permit is available for purchase online at a prorated rate at https://lsu.t2hosted.com/Account/Portal.

If your Tiger does not purchase a permit and wishes to park your vehicle on campus, they will be required to park in one of the over 650 metered spaces across campus at the rate of \$1.50 per hour. Students who park in one of the metered spaces are encouraged to use the ParkMobile Payment system. The ParkMobile app is available free of charge on any Apple or Android device.
