



International Travel for Spring Break and Beyond

Global Initiatives supports all Miami University students in their international travel. Students traveling internationally with student organizations over Spring

Break, during the Spring Term, or during the Summer Session, must register their travel with Global Initiatives, and purchase supplemental health insurance. You may be familiar with this system if you have studied abroad in the past.

To register your travel, go to <u>miamioh.edu/education-abroad/studentorgtravel</u> and sign in with your Miami unique ID and password.

You will be asked to:

- · Upload a copy of your passport
- Provide emergency contact information
- Provide onsite contact information
- · Purchase supplemental health insurance through GeoBlue (you will be provided information on how to do this)
- Provide optional medical information
- · Provide travel itinerary, including housing and flights
- · Provide student organization information, including a contact
- Review and sign an Assumption of Risk and Release
- Enroll in the Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP) through the U.S. Department of State
- Provide authorization for medical procedures

Thank you for contributing to safe and healthy travel for all as we continue to gather all of the information necessary to respond to the spread of the Coronavirus.
