Kick Off Your New Year with a Watershed Resolution

How many of Alpine County's watersheds have you seen? With five pristine watersheds, Alpine County is a wonder waiting to be explored. Trek one of the 120 mountain peaks ranging in elevation from 5,591 to 11,459 feet. Enjoy one of the three dozen campgrounds, or adventure through the thousands of acres of dispersed camping. When the weather is warmer, try the calming waters of more than 60 streams and lakes—perfect for a day of fishing and relaxing.

Alpine County houses two federal wilderness areas and three National Forests, amazing places to hike and backpack. Snowshoeing is a super way to be outdoors for all ages, and there are fantastic trails in the Bear Valley and Kirkwood areas. Getting outside not only improves physical health, but it bolsters mental health and can connect you with like-minded people in your own community. You do not have to go far to wander your watershed; it can be your backyard! Update at Board of Supervisors Meeting

On December 18, 2018, AWG attended the Alpine County Board of Supervisors meeting with several updates. Kimra introduced Shauna and Taylor as the new AmeriCorps members serving Alpine County until September 2019. Board Chair Rich Harvey and Mo presented initial data from 2018 monitoring for Pharmaceuticals and Personal Care Products (PPCPs). Mo gave an update on the Hope Valley project timeline. Permit applications will be submitted this winter. Construction is anticipated to start this summer and be completed by this fall.

Our Little Free Library has been moved back in front of the AWG office. It is moved to Turtle Rock Park Campground each spring when the campground is open and moved to the AWG office in the winter so the books are accessible in every season.
