- Tourist traffic from the US is expected to pick up in the coming months thanks to
 the launch of 56 direct flights a week to Athens, set to bring more than 1 million
 travelers to Greece and generate 1 billion euros in tourism revenue this year.
- Americans made the largest number of online searches for accommodation in Athens in 2022, reflecting an increasing demand from the US, according to data released by Tourix. According to the tourism marketing company, searches for accommodation in Athens from the US marked the largest percentage change in 2022 compared to 2019.
- Greece is on the radar for travelers from long-haul markets making it among the Top 10 preferred destinations in Europe, according to the latest Long-Haul Travel Barometer January-April 2023 released this week by the European Travel Commission (ETC) in collaboration with Eurail BV.

The Icebergs Cometh!




The vast


