





Spectrum Pride Panels

Pride Panels provide insight into the lives of real LGBTQ+ people who go to Miami in a way that allows people to ask questions honestly and without fear of judgment. Pride Panels are about facilitating conversation and practicing Love and Honor. At a Pride Panel, members of Spectrum come and answer questions about their lived experiences as LGBTQ+ people, both relating to topics you want to cover and about life in general. After brief introductions and setting some ground rules, the floor will be opened to questions; students often submit questions anonymously ahead of time as well as having an open Q&A.

Pride Panels have been very successful across the board, and Spectrum has received positive feedback from students and professors alike. Students walk away feeling as though they have a new perspective on LGBTQ+ issues, as well as a better understanding of the ways LGBTQ+ students experience life on campus and off.
