


UP Updates

MCAT UPDATES

Please note that as of today all MCAT tests from March 27th - May 21st have been canceled globally. SOME testing centers have cancled May 29th tests.

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Registration will open May 7th for the updated testing calendar for this cycle. If your testing date was canceled you will need to log in on May 7th and pick a new date. We recommend you log in as early as possible this day to get your first choice pick for rescheduling.

Also, please note that the AAMC has committed to reducing the processing time for scores from 4 weeks to 2 weeks for this testing cycle.

If you are registered for another type of entrance exam please make sure you are looking for direct communication from the testing company for further instructions during this time.

- D. II and III only


