There will be food provided ALL day (so that's a plus!)

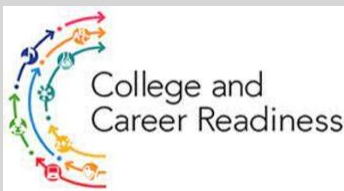
