#### This session's topic will be: The Personal Statement

During this session, medical students will be proofreading and editing personal statements, while giving feedback to everyone who joins our session. These statements will be proofread by medical students prior to the workshop session. We will split participants up into breakout rooms so that medical students can provide feedback to students on their personal statement.

## **Alumni Spotlight**

Erin Faloon is currently an M1 at Creighton University School of Medicine. Like many UP alumni, Erin chose to take a gap year after graduating in 2019. During that time, she spent a year living in Honduras and working with Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos (NPH), an organization that supports the rights of children and people with disabilities. In addition to living on the NPH "ranch" and helping to care for children who live there, she also worked in the community outreach department. Through this position, she had the opportunity to know and serve families living in cities and villages surrounding the ranch. She coordinated a nutrition program for babies 6 months -3 years, food donations to the Comedor (an NPH sponsored soup kitchen), provided tutoring services at the Comedor, assisted in coordination of scholarship program (meetings, workshops, tutoring, etc), conducted house visits to check in with families in our various programs, and assisted in the development of an under-construction family center. Erin left Honduras in June but will certainly continue to



do great things and impact the lives of many more in the future. We wish Erin all the best in medical school and with her future as a physician.




