



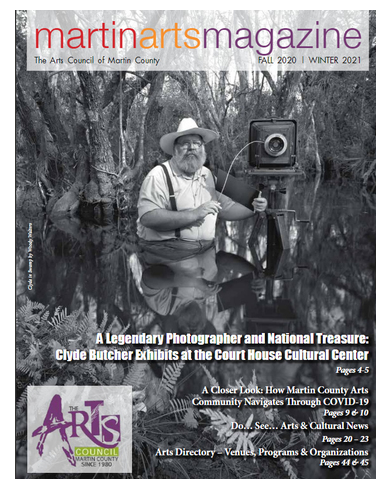

Arts Center at Stuart High School - Project Update

We are one step closer to achieving a long term goal to create a cultural campus in downtown Stuart. Last week the Martin County School Board voted unanimously to allow **Straticon Construction** 60 days, starting April 1st to inspect and evaluate the historic buildings for renovation and repurposing as an arts, cultural and destination center. This inspection period will indicate how much funding will need to be raised, determine feasibility, and become the foundation needed to launch the capital campaign to renovate.

The two acre site is ideal for our needs and is situated at the east end of the of the City of Stuart and will be near City Hall once it relocates to the building across from Memorial Park. The campus will enhance opportunities for creative learning with Stuart Middle School students and the future Boys & Girls Clubs, also to be located nearby. Adaptive reuse of this facility keeps the public space open for the whole community and celebrates its legacy form 1923-1964 as a school to our community's youth.

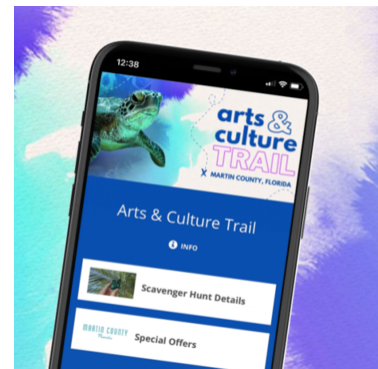

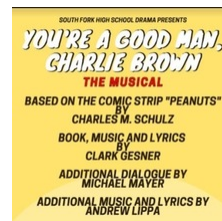
