Install antivirus on your devices. This is required for access to our network. Find <u>Information about Antivirus Software</u> in the ITS Knowledge Base.

Pack these items:

- "Restore media" discs used to install your software in case you need to reinstall
- Laptop cables (for security)
- Coax TV cables for all residence halls except Rountree

Verify your TV has a QAM tuner. For all halls, your TV must have a QAM tuner in order to receive the new digital channels. Please check the model number with the manufacture to verify that your TV has the correct equipment to receive the on-campus cable. For additional information, check the ITS Knowledge Base under "cable TV".

Check your cell phone coverage. The best services that work in the Platteville area are US Cellular and Verizon. If you have anything else, you may want to investigate alternatives.

Plan your eats. Effective immediately, you can add money to your eAccount at <u>https://www.uwplatt.edu/passport/e-accounts</u>. After you create your online account, you can download the Blackboard Transact Mobile eAccounts app for your mobile device for future convenience!

Printing allowance. Every student receives an allowance of \$3 each semester toward printing from campus devices. Check out full details in the <u>Student Printing Policy and Procedures</u>.

Network storage. 5GB of storage - FREE - backed-up, secure, and available from any campus computer PLUS any device with internet access via <u>Online Storage</u>.

Virtual desktops. Not feeling well? Don't feel like tromping through the Wisconsin winter to visit the computer lab? <u>Download</u> <u>the virtual client</u> and access general lab software AND your network storage from your personal device!

Equipment checkout. The ITS Help Desk has laptops, media equipment, and more available for checkout - free of charge! Check out <u>our website</u> for full details.

UW-Platteville app. Your connection to UW-Platteville through your mobile device. <u>Available for both iOS and Android</u>.

Your campus password is the key to all of your personal information, grades, coursework everything.

Follow the Toothbrush Rule and share with no one

- not even your parents!

Repeat after me: ITS will <u>never</u> ask for your username and password in an email... or via a link in an email... or via a form a link in an email. Never, ever. SERIOUSLY! If we need you to log into a system to troubleshoot an issue, we will have you log in for us.

Information security is everyone's responsibility. Your uwplatt email account is your official campus account - PLEASE CHECK IT REGULARLY!

Unfortunately, not all email is official or friendly. Phishing attacks try to con you out of your money, your identity, or your access to other Pioneers and campus systems. Problem is, phishing messages can appear quite safe. Jan 22 Spring Classes Begin

How can you tell what is legitimate from what is malicious?? A

suspicious message may ...

• Contain all sorts of spelling or grammatical errors - or makes no sense.

• Not be signed by an official campus department (like the ITS Help Desk) or employee and does not include contact information.

• Urge you to take some immediate action such as "verifying your account"

Gotta see it to believe it? We have mocked up <u>real-life examples</u> for you in the ITS Knowledge Base.

What do you do if you get a suspicious email? <u>Report it</u> to the ITS Help Desk if you have time. Otherwise just delete it. Better safe than sorry, we say.

One more time with feeling... ITS will never ask for your username and password in an email... or via a link in an email... or via a form from a link in an email. Never, ever. SERIOUSLY!
