Sneez - Real-Time Illness Tracker

Sneez is web-based tool that helps you track what is going around in your community. When you enter your zip code on the website a heat map will appear showing incidences and spikes in their area for 26 groups of common illnesses – from pink eye and strep throat to influenza and COVID-19. Sneez currently tracks illnesses in the Charlotte and Winston-Salem areas.



- Each day, Sneez receives secure and anonymous diagnosis data from partner health system so the tracking map is based on what community medical practices are diagnosing in real-time.
- Users can select "connect to care" to schedule an appointment with a healthcare provider in their area or remotely.
- Sign-up for alerts and stay informed when illnesses spike in their area.
- Users can also choose to save a link to Sneez right on their desktop or home screen, for easy access.
