Freshmen and sophomore students with less than 60 credits who are living in the residence halls are required to be on a meal plan. Off-campus students may choose to participate in the meal plan program.

Students have until September 21st to make any changes to their meal plans. There will be a \$20 change fee assessed during this time period for any changes.

Your meal plan covers a certain amount of money, depending on the time of day and where you choose to eat. <u>Cash Equivalency</u> is used at all Dining Services locations except for Stations, the all-you-care-to-eat facility. The cash equivalency and meal periods are as follows:

\$3.75 Breakfast [7 a.m.-10:15 a.m.]

\$4.75 Lunch [10:30 a.m.-3:15 p.m.]

\$5.50 Dinner [3:30 a.m.-1 a.m.]

Saturday-Sunday

\$4.75 Brunch [10:30 a.m.-3:15 p.m.]

\$5.50 Dinner [3:30 p.m.-1 a.m.]

Textbook Center

One of your first adventures on campus will involve finding your way to the <u>Textbook Center</u>. The Textbook Center is located in the basement of Doudna Hall (029 Doudna), and depending on what entrance you use, you may need to walk a maze of hallways before you find your way there.

Bring your Pioneer Passport I.D. Card! Backpacks are not allowed in the Textbook Center (a plastic carrying bag is provided). However, there is a shelf provided outside to place your backpack as some textbooks are quite heavy. The calculus book alone weighs more than 6 pounds.

The Textbook Center extends their hours of operation during Welcome Weekend and the first week of classes. For a list of hours, visit the Textbook Center website. Students receive a free student planner at pick up (while supplies last).

NOTE: A few courses require supplies or workbooks that must be purchased. For example, students enrolled in English 1130 or 1230 will need to purchase their required composition textbook, Stylus: An Anthology of College Writing, at the University Bookstore in the Markee Pioneer Student Center (MPSC). This textbook is NOT available at the Textbook Rental Center.

I.D. (Pioneer Passport)

Your Pioneer Passport is going to be one of the most important things to keep with you ALL the time. Your I.D. is required for a lot of things on campus, such as printing on campus; entry into labs; checking out textbook; attending athletic events; and using the Pioneer Activity Center (PAC).

The Pioneer Passport is the official ID card for the University of Wisconsin-Platteville. Your Passport is expected to last your entire college career. There is no charge for your first Passport; however, there is a \$20.00 replacement fee. The Passport Office also issues Voter IDs to UWP students at no charge.

If you lose your Pioneer Passport, or are having problems with it, contact the Pioneer Passport office as soon as possible. Lost

Dining Dollars vs. Passport Funds

Confused about when to use Dining Dollars and Passport Funds? Here's a guide for you!

<u>Dining Dollars</u> are used for purchasing food only. The Dining Dollar funds expire at the end of the current academic year (next May).

<u>Passport Funds</u> are another way to pay for food. This money stays on your account for the entire time you are at UW-Platteville. Passport Funds are also redeemable at the bookstore, the information center, printing, and laundry machines in the residence halls (except for Rountree).

Both methods save five percent on all purchases at Dining Services locations, compared to paying with cash or credit card. Your can track balances and add funds via eAccounts at https://www.uwplatt.edu/passport/e-accounts.
