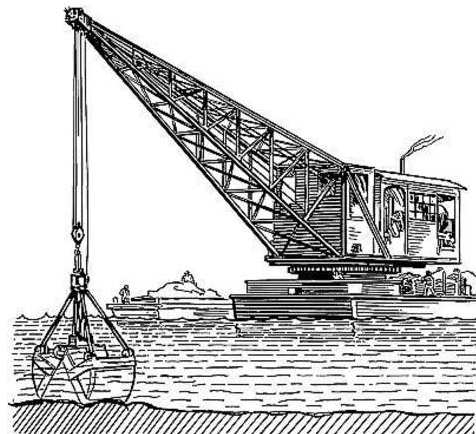
Connections for the STEM Classroom
