Iceland's Frozen Giant - Vatnajokull National Park



A UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2019, Vatnajökull is the largest of Iceland's three national parks and includes the Vatnajökull glacier, Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon and Askja volcano.

Created to safeguard a variety of geological, botanical and historic agricultural features, Vatnajökull covers roughly 13% of Iceland's land mass. Which also makes it one of the largest national parks in Europe. Total size is 5,375 square miles, or roughly the same size as Yellowstone and Grand Canyon national parks combined. In other words: Huge!

Gozo is the living embodiment of the adage: Good Things Come In Small Packages.


History and outdoor adventures. Awesome food and incredible places to overnight. And did we mention it might be even more gorgeous than the big island?


