



Game Day Information

Greetings!

Family Weekend will be here in just two short days! We know you're so excited to see your Tiger and have a fun-filled weekend on campus. This will be our largest Family Weekend ever, with almost 8,000 people in attendance, and we can't wait to see you!

This weekend will be a hot one! The weather forecast calls for sunny skies with highs in the mid-90s (RealFeel over 100 degrees). Be sure to pack your sunscreen, dress accordingly, and hydrate.

GAME DAY GUIDE

Get ready to cheer on our Fighting Tigers as they take on the New Mexico Lobos on Saturday, September 24! [Lsusports.net/gameday](https://lsusports.net/gameday) is the hub for general information about Tiger Stadium, parking, the timeline, etc.

When should we arrive to campus?

Due to the heavy volume of people on campus on game day, it is not feasible to drive through campus. We encourage you to park and be prepared to walk everywhere. Come as early as you can! The Family Weekend Tailgate will be held from 1:00 - 4:00 p.m. on the [LSU Parade Ground](#) (the big grassy area across from the LSU Student Union). Look for the white tents and balloons!

All football tickets will be mobile and sent via email to the email address used for your purchase. If you have not received your football tickets via email yet, please check your junk/spam folder. You may also contact the LSU Athletic Ticket Office at (225) 578-0100 or tickets@lsu.edu.

You are strongly encouraged to download your tickets ahead of time and save them to your mobile device. The cellphone reception and wireless connection around campus on gameday can be slower than usual.

Join us inside the Maravich Center from 1:30-5:30 p.m. to watch games and see The Golden Band perform.

Parking Directions
Get directions to your specific parking lot using the Waze app customized for entering campus on GameDay.

Victory Hill
Watch the parade starting 2 1/2 hours prior to kickoff on North Stadium Dr.

Water Bottle
Fans may bring a sealed 1-liter water bottle into Tiger Stadium.

Mobile Tickets
Be sure to download your digital ticket onto your mobile device prior to arriving on campus.

What items are allowed in Tiger Stadium?

- All seats in the Family Weekend sections in Tiger Stadium are bench seats, which means that they will not have a seat back. You are welcome to bring your own seat cushion (no larger than 16").
- [Stadium-approved clear bag](#) (each family will receive one free bag at Family Weekend check-in)

Other Items to bring:

- Your football tickets. Be sure to download your digital ticket onto your mobile device prior to arriving to campus.
- Hand sanitizer or wipes
- Portable phone charger or cord
- Sunscreen and sun protection
- While there will be some seating provided at the Family Weekend Tailgate, you are welcome to bring chairs and other items to the tailgate.

Will alcohol be served at the Family Weekend Tailgate?

- Alcohol will not be served at our Family Weekend Tailgate, but you're welcome to bring in your own beverages (alcoholic and non-alcoholic) to the LSU Family Weekend Tailgate. Glass containers are strongly discouraged for use during tailgating activities.

**Please note that there is no storage available for your items during the game. We recommend only bringing items to the tailgate that you can bring with you into Tiger Stadium or that can be disposed of or stored in your vehicle prior to the game.*

Learn the Cheers!

If this will be your first time in Tiger Stadium, you're in for a treat! Death Valley is one-of-a-kind,

and the passion and spirit from our fans is electric. You'll see that we have a cheer for almost everything. Don't worry - the cheers are easy, and you'll catch on quickly. The words to Fight for LSU (the fight song) and our Alma Mater are printed on the back of your Family Weekend nametag, so it will be easy for you to follow along.

Sportsmanship and Fan Behavior

LSU encourages its fans to show good sportsmanship and conduct themselves in a manner that represents LSU, the Southeastern Conference and the NCAA with honor, dignity and respect. All fans in attendance shall demonstrate the qualities of civility and sportsmanship at all times.

- Refrain from the use of vulgar, abusive, racist, sexist, demeaning or intimidating language at any time.
- Always support the players, coaches and officials in a positive manner.
- Treat the visiting team, coaches and fans with courtesy and respect at all times.
- Refrain from engaging in cheers that are vulgar, crass or demeaning.
- Refrain from throwing objects for any reason.
